

## Drawing From A Fanny Pack

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**EMPTY YOUR HANDGUN BEFORE PRACTICING THIS DRAW!**

The normal position of the fanny pack rip-cord is on the GUN HAND side of the fanny pack. Pull the rip-cord to the outside of the fanny pack and zip it together with BOTH zippers.



The draw begins by grasping the rip-cord with the SUPPORT HAND (if you are right handed, it's your LEFT hand). The rip-cord will be pulled back toward your support side.

NOTE: Do not place thumb in loop as shown, this was done because we had to stop many times during the picture session to get just the right shot for demonstration!



Rip open the gun compartment far enough to get a full combat grip on your handgun. "Rip-open" means as fast as you can WITHOUT tearing the fanny pack off your body and throwing it at the bad guy. (Yes, the stories you've heard about this happening are true). Use the belt-strap on the back of the fanny pack whenever you can.



Obtain a full combat grip on the handgun then break the thumb-break snap to free the handgun. **LEARN TO KEEP YOUR TRIGGER FINGER STRAIGHT RESTING ON THE FRAME UNTIL YOU ARE READY TO FIRE THE GUN. THIS GOES: ON THE RANGE OR ANYTIME YOU PICK UP A FIREARM.**



Pull the handgun out in a motion back around your gun hand side. Push the gun out and bring your hands together for a strong Weaver Stance with full combat grip.

**DID YOU MAKE SURE YOUR HANDGUN WAS UNLOADED? DO ME A FAVOR, CHECK IT ONE MORE TIME!**
